Under Section 28A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (Central Act XLIII of 1951), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares all Police Officers from the level of Director General of Police, Additional Director General of Police (Law and Order), Additional Director General of Police and Commissioner of Police, Chennai, Commissioner of Police, Chennai Suburban Commissionerate, Additional Directors General of Police, Inspectors General of Police, Zonal Inspectors General of Police, North, South, Central and West, Commissioners of Police, Salem, Madurai, Coimbatore, Tiruchirappalli and Tirunelveli Range, Deputy Inspectors General of Police, Superintendents of Police of the Districts, Sub-Divisional Police Officers, Officers immediately subordinate to them and up to the level of Head Constables and Police Constables (including Home Guards) and any other Police Officer performing in any way election related duties, as Designated Officers for the conduct of General Elections to the Lok Sabha, 2009.
