The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 27th July 2009 and is hereby published for general information:-

ACT No. 7 OF 2009

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies Act, 1983.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Act,

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd day of May 2009.

2. In section 89 of the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies Act, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in the proviso to sub-section (1), for the expression "eight years", the expression "eight years and six months" shall be substituted.

3. (1) The Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 2009 is hereby Tamil Nadu repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the principal Act, as amended by the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the principal Act, as amended by this Act.

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 27th July 2009 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 8 OF 2009

An Act to provide for the appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2009.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2009.

2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2009, a sum not exceeding seventy six thousand nine hundred and forty eight crores sixty three lakhs and fifty six thousand rupees which shall be inclusive of the sum of thirty eight thousand five hundred and thirty four crores nine lakhs and fifty seven thousand rupees specified in section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2009 being moneys required to meet—

Tamil Nadu Act 6 of 2009. Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2009.
