Whereas in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of the Articles 258 of the Constitution of India, the President of India has, in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Co-operation (Department of Agriculture) Notification No.4 (i)/65, General I & II, dated the 23rd April, 1966 entrusted to the Government of Tamil Nadu with their consent, the function of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894) in relation to Acquisition of Land for the purpose for the Union in this State.

And, whereas, the lands specified in the Schedule below are needed for a public purpose to wit for Road Over Bridge approach area due to the formation of Salem-Karur Broad Gauge Railwayline Project, notified to the effect is hereby given to all to whom It may concern in accordance with the provision of sub-section (1) of the Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894);
