CONSTITUTION OF DISTRICT MUNSIF'S COURT AT KATPADI IN VELLORE DISTRICT  
UNDER THE TAMIL NADU CIVIL COURTS ACT.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court, Madras, hereby fixes the number of District Munsif to be appointed to the District Munsif's Court, Katpadi in Vellore District as **One** with effect on and from the date on which the District Munsif, Katpadi assumes charge of that Court.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby varies the local limits of the jurisdiction of the Subordinate Judge's Court in Vellore District to the effect that the said Subordinate Judge's Court, Vellore, shall have and exercise original jurisdiction over the District Munsif's Court, Katpadi in Vellore District in addition to its existing jurisdiction with effect on and from the date on which the District Munsif, Katpadi assumes charge of that Court.
