APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSION OF INQUIRY TO INQUIRE INTO THE DEMISE OF THE LATE HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER OF TAMIL NADU SELVI J JAYALALITHAA ON 5TH DECEMBER 2016 UNDER THE COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ACT.

Whereas, the Government of Tamil Nadu is of the opinion that it is necessary to appoint a Commission of Inquiry headed by a retired Judge of High Court of Madras for the purpose of making an independent inquiry into the demise of the late Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Selvi J Jayalalithaa;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 (Central Act LX of 1952), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby appoints a Commission of Inquiry consisting of a single member, namely, Hon'ble Justice Thiru A. Arumughaswamy, retired Judge of High Court of Madras:

- 3. The Commission will complete its inquiry and submit its report (both English and Tamil) to the Government within a period of three months from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*;
- 4. And whereas, the Government of Tamil Nadu is of the opinion, having regard to the nature of the inquiry to be made by the Commission of Inquiry and other circumstances of the case, that all the provisions of sub-sections (2), (3), (4) and (5) of Section 5 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 (Central Act LX of 1952) shall be made applicable to the Commission of Inquiry;
- 5. Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 (Central Act LX of 1952), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby directs that all the provisions of Sub-sections (2), (3), (4) and (5) of Section 5 of the said Act shall apply to the Commission of Inquiry.
