EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR FILING OF CLAIMS AND OBJECTIONS IN THE CONSTITUENCIES OF THE TAMIL NADU LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

## No. SRO G-33/2017.

The following Notification of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi, dated 23rd October, 2017 [1 Kartika, 1939 (Saka)] is published:

No. 23/NOT/ECI/FUNC/ERD-ER/2017 (Vol.II). Whereas, the Commission had announced the schedule for Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls with reference to 01.01.2018 as the qualifying date, *vide* its letter No.23/LET/ECI/FUNC/ERD-ER/2017 (Vol.II), dated 23rd August, 2017; and

Whereas, the period of filing claims and objections was fixed from 3rd October, 2017 to 31st October, 2017; and

Whereas, the draft rolls were published on 3rd October, 2017 as scheduled; and

Whereas, the Election Commission has reviewed the ongoing exercise of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls in the State; and

Whereas, the Election Commission has, on such review, decided that the period of filing claims and objections in the State should be extended up to 30th November, 2017, so that a Special Verification Drive within the ongoing Summary Revision can be undertaken in which Booth Level Officers would visit house to house for the purpose;

Now, therefore, the Election Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Rule 12 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, hereby extends the period for filling claims and objections in the State upto and including 30th November, 2017 for ongoing Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls with reference to 01.01.2018 as the qualifying date.
