COVID-19 - RESTRICTIONS IN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTIONS OF THE ESTATE OF TAMIL NADU TILL 24:00 HRS OF 31-08-2020 WITH GUIDELINES AND RELAXATIONS TO PERMIT THE RESTAURANTS TO FUNCTION WITH AIR CONDITIONING AND VENTILATION UNDER THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2005.

WHEREAS on considering the recommendations of the expert team of Doctors and Public Health Specialists and based on the directive of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, State-wide lockdown was extended from time to time and lastly extended till 24:00 hrs of 30-09-2020 under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 in the order 9th read above.

2. In the order 4th read above, Restaurants were permitted to function with effect from 8.6.2020 with dine-in facilities from 6.00 A.M. to 8.00 P.M. with 50% of seating capacity maintaining social distancing and without air conditioning throughout the State and Standard Operating Procedures also issued for the Customers / Owners / Managers / Workers of the Restaurants in Tamil Nadu in the order 5th read above.

3. Further in the Order 8th read above, among others issued orders permitting the Restaurants in Greater Chennai Police Limits to function with dine-in facilities with 50% of seating capacity by following the Standard Operating Procedure issued already, from 6.00 A.M. to 7.00 P.M without air conditioning facility. In the order 9th read above, the Restaurants were permitted to function upto 8.00 P.M.

4. In the order 9th read above, the Government have also permitted the Shopping Malls, all showrooms and big format shops (viz. jewellery and textiles shops) throughout the State with air conditioning facility by following the guidelines issued by Government of India for air conditioning and ventilation.

5. Accordingly the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration has sent the amendment proposal to the G.O.Ms.No.447, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, dated 31.08.2020 to permit the Restaurants to function with air conditioning facility by following the guidelines issued by Government of India for air conditioning and ventilation.

6. Now therefore the Government hereby accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration and amend the G.O.Ms.No.447, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, dated 31.08.2020 as follows:

The following content in Section (vii) under Caption II - (Permitted Activities) may be replaced as detailed below:-

- vii. Following the Standard Operating Procedures already issued by Government, Restaurants are permitted to function from 6.00 A.M. to 8.00 P.M. **with air conditioning facility** by following the guidelines issued Government of India for air conditioning and ventilation and that take away (parcel food) will be permitted upto 9.00 P.M. Further, Tea Shops are permitted to function from 6.00 A.M. to 8.00 P.M.
