AMENDMENTS TO THE TAMIL NADU URBAN LOCAL BODIES RULES, 2023

[G.O. Ms. No. 89, Municipal Administration and Water Supply (Elec.), 4th July 2023,

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 198 of the Tamil Nadu Urban Local Bodies Act, 1998 (Tamil Nadu Act 9 of 1999), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Urban Local Bodies Rules, 2023:—

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Rules,—

(1) in rule 244, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) The Commissioner shall, at the beginning of the financial year invite applications in Form 1 from any person desirous to have his name registered as a registered contractor for the execution of any municipal work of general or special nature.”;

(2) in rule 245,—

(a) for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) All municipal works and purchases shall be carried out in accordance with the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 (Tamil Nadu Act 43 of 1998), the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Rules, 2000 and the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders (Public Private Partnership Procurement) Rules, 2012.”;

(b) after sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be added, namely:—

“(4) In case of civil and electrical works, the successful bidder shall register as a contractor with the municipality before execution of the agreement, if not already registered.”;

(3) for rule 246, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“**246. Security or solvency of the contractors.**— The Commissioner shall obtain security and solvency at two percent of the contracted amount in accordance with the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 (Tamil Nadu Act 43 of 1998), the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Rules, 2000 and the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders (Public Private Partnership Procurement) Rules, 2012.”;

(4) in rule 248, in sub-rule (1), for the tables thereunder, the following tables shall be substituted, namely:—

Explanation.— For the purposes of this Chapter,

(1) in case of any project/work, for which the contribution of the Central or State Government or both, including the loan repayable by Government, is eighty per cent or more of the estimated cost, such work shall be deemed to be as 'predominantly funded by Government';

(2) in case of any work, for which the contribution of the municipality from its own fund, including the loan repayable by Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council or Town Panchayat, as the case may be, exceeds twenty per cent of the estimated cost, such work shall be deemed to be as 'partly funded from municipal fund'."
