Declaration of Tiruttani Forest Block of Tiruvallur District as Reserved Forest under the Act.

No.II(2)/EF/602/2008.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares the area, the boundaries of which are specified in the Schedule below as reserved forest with effect on and from 26th May 2009.

BOUNDARIES

(1) Bit-I Survey Field Numbers 334/2 and 334/3 of Village Number 21. Tiruttani Village.

North.—Starting from the trijunction of Survey Field Numbers 334/1 and 334/2 of Village Number 21. Tiruttani Village and Survey Field Number 98. of Village Number 17. Amirthapuram Village, the boundary generally runs towards north east and then towards East along the eastern, southern and eastern sides of Survey Field number 334/1 of Village Number 21. Tiruttani Village and part in southern side Survey Field Number 97 of Village Number 17. Amirthapuram Village till it meets the trijunction point of Survey Field Number 97 of Village Number 17. Amirthapuram Village and Survey Field Number 28 and 334/3 of Village number 21. Tiruttani Village.

East.—Thence the boundary runs towards south along Numbers 28 and 29 of village number 21. Tiruttani Village till it meets the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 29 and 334/3 of Village number 21. Tiruttani Village and Survey Field Number 351/1 of village number 21. Madam Village.

South.—Thence the boundary runs towards west along the Northern side of Survey Field Number 351/1 of Village number 21 Madam Village till it meets the junction of Survey Field Number 351/1 of Village number 21. Madam Village and Survey Field Numbers 352 and 334/3 of Village number 21 of Tiruttani Village.

West.—Thence the boundary runs towards north along the Eastern side of Survey Field Numbers 352 and 353 of Village number 21. Tiruttani Village, Southern, eastern sides of Survey Field Number 98 of Village number 17. Amirthapuram Village southern and eastern side of Survey Field No. 334/2 of No. 21. Tiruttani Village till it meets the starting point.

(2) Bit-II Survey Field Number 335 of Village Number 21. Tiruttani Village.

North.—Starting from the Village trijunction of Survey Field Number 56 of village number 20. Karthikeyapuram Village, Survey Number 356 of Village number 21. Madam Village till it meets the trijunction point of Survey Field Number 351/1 of Village number 21. Madam Village and Survey Field Number 288 and 335 of Village number 21. Tiruttani Village.

East.—Thence the boundary runs towards south along the western side of Survey Field Number 288 of Village number 21. Tiruttani Village till it meets the trijunction of Survey Field Numbers 288, 355 and 289 of Village number 21. Tiruttani Village.

South.—Thence the boundary runs towards west along the northern side of Survey Field Number 289 of Village number 21. Tiruttani Village and Survey Field Number 78 of village number 20. Karthikeyapuram village till it meets the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 78, 80, 77 and 56 of Village number 20. Karthikeyapuram Village.

West.—Thence the boundary runs towards north along the eastern side of Survey Field Number 56 of village number 20. Karthikeyapuram Village till it meets the starting point.

ADMITTED RIGHTS

Right Number-1.—Right is admitted to the Executive Officer, Arulmigu Subramaniasamy Devasthanam to lit Deepam on the top of hill in Survey Field Number 334/3. The Deepam is lit on the stone on the top of hill (During the Karthigai Deepam). A pathway to reach this place is admitted. It enters the Forest Block at a cutting point of 147.2 metres in a length of 294.00 metres on the eastern side of the Survey Field Number 334/3. The width of the pathway is one metre and length of pathway is 259 metres. The bearing and distance of the pathway is as follows:—

Right Number-2.—Right is admitted to the public to use the pathway leading to the borewell in Survey Field Number 334/3 on the south west corner of the Forest Block. The pathway enters the Forest Block on the north west corner of Survey Field Number 351/1 of village number 21. Madam Village and runs towards north and leaves the Forest Block on the eastern side of Survey Field Number 98. The borewell is situated on the eastern side of the pathway. The length of the pathway is 223.6 metres and width is 4 metres. The bearing and distance of the pathway is as follows:—

There is a pathway from K to A at cutting point of 51 metres from southern side of this land. People are permitted to use this pathway to go Samiyar Mutt and offer prayers. The area of the Mutt is 5.40 x 10.20m. The length of the path way is 318 and width is one metre. The bearing and distance of the pathway is as follows:—

Nagoor Village of Nagapattinam Town, the boundary runs generally Eastwards along the southern side of Survey Field Numbers 613/1, 614/1, 614/2A and 615/1, till it meets the trijunction of Survey Field Number 615/2, Survey Field Number 615/1 and Bay of Bengal.

This burial ground is situated on the Northern side of the Forest Block Survey Field Number 614/2B in an extent of 0.40 cents a pathway connecting the Fisherman colony (Survey Field Numbers 613/1 and 614/1) and burial ground (Survey Field Number 614/2B) and it enters in the Forest Block in the Northern boundary of Survey Field Number 614/2B at the cutting measurement of 264 feet (80 Metres) on the Field line measurement of 280 feet in between Sub-Division Numbers 614/2A and 2B. Then it passes through the forest block towards Southern directions with a width of 4 metres and to a length of 189.2 metres (624 feet) with the following magnetic bearings and distances:—

Right Number 2.—Pathway to the burial ground (Mayanam) for the use of Adi-Dravida Community people of Paipannaicheri and Kadambadi Hamlet of Nagore Villages. Right of pathway is allowed to the people of Adi-Dravida Community people of Paipannaicheri and Kadambadi Hamlet of Nagore Village to reach the burial ground (Mayanam) which is situated in the Eastern side of the Forest Block.

This pathway is entering the Forest Block at the cutting measurement of 245 feet (74.4 metres) on the forest line measurement 1137 feet in between Sub-Division Numbers 603/1 and 603/2. Then it passes through the the Forest Block (603/2) towards East direction with a width of 4 metres (13 Feet) and to a length of 32.8 metres (108 feet) and it reaches the Mayanam at the cutting measurement

HOME, PROHIBITION AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT

Exemption from operation of certain rule to carryout modifications in respect of Thiruvalluvar Empee Distilleries Limited, Mevalooruppam at Kancheepuram District under the Tamil Nadu Indian Made Foreign Spirits (Manufacture) Rules, 1981.

[G.O. Ms. No. 99, Home, Prohibition and Excise (III), 2nd December 2008.]

No. II(2)/HOPE/607/2008.—In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 35 of the Tamil Nadu Indian-made Foreign Spirits (Manufacture) Rules, 1981, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts Thiruvalluvar Empee Distilleries Limited, Mevalooruppam, Kancheepuram District from the operation of sub-rule (2) of rule 11 of the said Rules for the period from 4th October 2007 to 12th March 2008 in having completed the following modifications on 12th March 2008, namely:—

- (i) Installation of 50 Kilo litres purification plant.
- (ii) Installation of 5 numbers of stainless steel tanks, 2 numbers of neutral spirit receiver tanks and 3 numbers of neutral spirit storage tanks.
- (iii) Installation of 3 numbers of head spirit storage tanks and 3 numbers mild steel tanks.
- (iv) Installation of one stainless steel oil tank in the proposed purification plant.
- (v) Erecting new 16 tons boiler by replacing one of the two 5 tons boilers.

2. This Notification shall be deemed to have come into force on the 4th day of October 2007.
