Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Educational Service.

[G.O.Ms. No. 144, Higher Education (B1), 15th June 2011, வைகாசி 32, திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2042.]

No.SRO B-27/2011.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Educational Service (Section 8-Tamil Nadu Services Manual, Volume-II).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 5th May 2010.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Special Rules,—

(1) in rule 1, under the heading "Section A - Administrative Posts", in Class V, for Categories "3. Lecturers in Engineering Subjects in Engineering Colleges" and "4. Lecturers in Non-Engineering Subjects in Engineering Colleges", the following Categories shall be substituted, namely:—

"3. Assistant Professor in Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges.

4. Assistant Professor in Non-Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges." ;

(2) In rule 2, in sub-rule (a), in the tabular columns, under Class V, in the first column,—

(i) for "Category 3—Lecturers in Engineering subjects, Engineering Colleges", the following Category shall be substituted, namely:—

"Category 3—Assistant Professor in Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges" ;

(ii) for "Category 4—Lecturers in Non-Engineering Subjects, Engineering Colleges", the following Category shall be substituted, namely:—

"Category 4—Assistant Professor in Non-Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges";

(3) in rule 3, in the proviso, for item 3, the following item shall be substituted, namely:—

"3. Assistant Professors in Engineering Colleges." ;

(4) In rule 11, for the expression "Lecturers in Engineering subjects and Lecturers in Non-Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges", the expression "Assistant Professor in Engineering subjects and Assistant Professor in Non-Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges" shall be substituted;

(5) In the Annexure, in the tabular columns,—

(i) for the entry "Lecturers in Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges" in column (3) and the corresponding entries in columns (4) and (5) thereof, against Class "V" in column (1) and Category "3" in column (2), the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:—

"Assistant Professor in Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges	Direct recruitment	B.E. or B. Tech. and M.E. or M. Tech. In the relevant branch of Engineering or Technology with First Class or its equivalent either in B.E. or B.Tech. or M.E. or M. Tech.";

(ii) for the entry "Lecturers in Non-Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges" in column (3) and the corresponding entries in columns (4) and (5) thereof, against Class "V" in column (1) and Category "4" in column (2), the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:—

"Assistant Professor in Non-Engineering subjects in Engineering Colleges	Direct recruitment	(1) Master's degree in the relevant subject with good academic record of not less than 55% of marks or an equivalent Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University; and (2) Pass in the National Eligibility Test (NET) for Lecturers conducted by the UGC, Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) or similar test accredited by the University Grants Commission: Provided that holders of Ph.D. degree are exempted from passing the said Test".
