ADI DRAVIDAR TRIBAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT

Amendment to the Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Higher Secondary Educational Service.

No. SRO B-43/2011.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Higher Secondary Educational Service:—

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on 10-11-2011.

In the said Special Rules, in rule 13, for the expression "1st March", the expression "1st January" shall be substituted.

FINANCE DEPARTMENT

Ad hoc rules relating to temporary post of System Programmer in the Finance Department.

[G.O. Ms. No. 315, Finance (OP-I), 16th November 2011, Aippasi 30, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2042.]

No. SRO B-44/2011.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules:—

2. The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th May, 2001.

RULES

The General and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent post of the Tamil Nadu General Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary post of System Programmer, sanctioned from time to time, in the Finance Department, subject to the modifications specified in following rules:—

2. **Constitution.**—The post shall constitute a distinct class of the said service.
3. **Appointment.**—Appointment to the post shall be made as follows:—
 - (i) by direct recruitment; or
 - (ii) by transfer from any other class or category; or
 - (iii) by recruitment by transfer from any other service.
4. **Preparation of annual list of approved candidates.**—For the purpose of preparation of annual list of approved candidates for appointment to the post shall be the 1st September every year.
5. **Appointing Authority.**—The appointing authority for the post shall be the Secretary to Government, Finance Department.
6. **Qualifications:**
 - (a) Age.— No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete the age of thirty years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.
 - (b) Other Qualification.— No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by the method specified in column (1) of the Table below unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:

<i>Method of Appointment</i>	<i>Qualification</i>

1. By direct recruitment	(i) Must have passed Bachelor's degree of Engineering in Computer Science and Engineering; or (ii) Must have passed Bachelor's degree of Technology in Computer Science and Engineering; or (iii) Must have passed Master's degree in Computer Applications; or (iv) Must have passed Master's degree of Science in Computer Science; and (v) Must possess practical experience in the field of system analysis, Design, operation, production or construction or testing information system, teaching, research or data processing through computer for a period of not less than three years in a Government or public sector or statutory or autonomous organization.
2. By transfer from any other class or category and	(i) Must have passed Bachelor's degree in Commerce or Mathematics (or) Applied Mathematics (or) Statistics (or) Economics;
3. By recruitment by transfer from any other service	(ii) Must have passed Post Graduate Degree or Diploma in Computer Application with specialization in atleast two programming languages and two Data Base Management softwares; (iii) Must possess experience in software development for a period of not less than three years and the said experience shall be in Fox Plus Programme, Fox Pro Programme, Basic Programme, Ms-Office 2000 and working knowledge in UNIX and Windows system and Management information System; (iv) Must possess work experience in Finance Department dealing with budget matters (i.e. Estimating and Compiling of Budget data) for a period of not less than one year.

7. Probation:

(a) Every Person appointed to the post by direct recruitment, shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

(b) Every person appointed to the post by recruitment by transfer shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

8. **Pay.**—There shall be paid to the holder of the post monthly pay calculated in the scale of pay of Rs. 6500-200-10500 provided that with effect on and from 30th July 2008 the monthly pay shall be calculated in the scale of pay of Rs. 8000-275-13500 (pre-revised).

9. **Savings.**—Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect the holders of the post on the date of issue of this order.
