Draft Amendments to the Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service (Tamil Nadu) Rules

[G.O. Ms. No. 64, Labour and Employment (K2), 25th June 2014, Aani 11, Jaya, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2045.]

No. SRO A-14/2014.—The following draft of amendments to the Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service (Tamil Nadu) Rules, 1983 which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 35 of the Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service Act, 1979, (Central Act 30 of 1979) is hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby as required under sub-section (1) of the said Section 35 of the said Act.

2. Notice is hereby given that the draft amendments will be taken into consideration on or before the expiry of the period of one month from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* and that objection or suggestion which may be received from any person with respect thereto, before the expiry of the aforesaid period will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Objections suggestions, if any should be addressed to the Secretary to Government, Labour and Employment Department, Chennai-600 009, through the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 009.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Rules,—

- (1) in rule 6, in sub-rule (4), for the expression, “rupees five”, the expression “five hundred rupees” shall be substituted;
- (2) for rule 12, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“12. Fees.—(1) The fees for the grant of certificate of registration of an establishment under sub-section (1) of Section 4 shall be as specified below:—

If the number of migrant workmen proposed to be employed in the establishment on any day—

(a) is 5 but does not exceed 50	2,500.00	
(b) exceeds 50 but does not exceed 100	5,000.00	
(c) exceeds 100 but does not exceed 200	10,000.00	
(d) exceeds 200	20,000.00	

- (2) The fees to be paid for grant or renewal of a licence under Section 8 shall be as specified below:—

If the number of workmen employed by the contractor on any day—

(a) is 5 but does not exceed 50	2,500.00	
(b) exceeds 50 but does not exceed 100	5,000.00	
(c) exceeds 100 but does not exceed 200	10,000.00	
(d) exceeds 200	20,000.00”;	

- (3) in rule 14, in sub-rule (3), for the expression “five rupees”, the expression “five hundred rupees” shall be substituted;
- (4) in rule 16, in sub-rule (2), for the expression “Rs.10”, the expression “five hundred rupees” shall be substituted.

Amendment to the Tamil Nadu Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Rules.

No. SRO A-15/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 15 of the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 (Central Act XX of 1946) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Rules, 1947, the draft of the same having been previously published as required under sub-section (1) of Section 15 of the said Act.

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force with effect on and from the date of the publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 3, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) Five copies of the draft standing orders in English and in Tamil which an employer proposes to adopt for his industrial establishment, shall be sent by him, by registered post, to the Certifying Officer along with the required number of spare copies to the trade union in the establishment”.
