AMENDMENTS TO THE AD HOC RULES FOR RELATING TO THE POST OF LIVESTOCK
INSPECTOR GRADE -II FOR ANIMAL HUSBANDRY SUBORDINATE SERVICES

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the ad hoc rules published in Agriculture Department Notification No.499, at page 1362 of Part I in Fort St. George Gazette dated 19th September 1956.

2. (i) The amendments hereby made in rule 1 shall be deemed to have come into force from the date 19th September 1977.

(ii) The amendments hereby made in rule 5 shall be deemed to have come into force from the date 8th December 1989.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said rules,

1. In rule 1 - for the expression "Livestock Assistant Grade II" the expression "Livestock Inspector Grade II" shall be substituted.

2. In rule 5, in clause (ii), for sub-clause (a) the following sub-clause shall be substituted, namely:

"must have passed Higher Secondary School"

3. for rules 3 to 8 the following rules, shall be substituted, namely:

3. Appointment.-Appointment to the posts shall be made by direct recruitment and by promotion from the post of Animal Husbandry Assistants in the ratio of 9:1 subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria prescribed in rule.

4. Appointing Authority.-The appointing authority for the posts shall be the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Chennai.

5. Qualification.-(a) Age.-No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has completed or will complete the age of 32 years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

(b) Other Qualification.- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by the method specified in column (2) of the table below, unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof.

<i>Sl.No.</i> (1)	<i>Method of Recruitment</i> (2)	<i>Qualifications</i> (3)
1.	By direct recruitment	(a) A degree from any recognized University. (b) A Pass in the higher secondary course with Biology or Botany or Zoology as one of the subjects.
2.	By promotion	(a) (i) A degree from any recognized University (ii) A Pass in the higher secondary course with Biology or Botany or Zoology as one of the subjects. (b) Must possess 5 years regular service in the Department. (c) Must have completed probation in the feeder category. (d) Should not have completed 56 years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the selection is made.

6. Probation.- Every person appointed to the post in a class or category in this service by direct recruitment shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

7. Test.- Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment or by promotion shall, within the period of his probation pass the following test:-

- (a) Must have completed 11 months Livestock Inspector Training. (Paid Training)
- (b) Animal Husbandry Department Test.

8. Pay.-There shall be paid to the holders of the post, a monthly pay calculated at appropriate level.

9. Transfer and postings.- (a) Regional Joint Directors of Animal Husbandry shall be competent to transfer Livestock Inspector Grade-II within their respective jurisdictions.

(b) The Director of Animal Husbandry Department shall be the competent authority to transfer Livestock Inspector Grade-II from one district to another district.

10. Reservation of appointments.-The provisions contained in Section 27 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016) shall apply to the post for which candidate are appointed by the direct recruitment.

11. Preparation of annual list of approved candidates.-The list of approved candidates for appointment to the post shall be prepared annually by the appointing authority and the crucial date on which the candidates should have acquired the prescribed qualifications shall be the 1st July of every year.
