AMENDMENTS TO THE TAMIL NADU HINDU RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS EMPLOYEES
(CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) RULES, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (xxiii) of sub-section (2) of section 116 of the Tamil Nadu Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Act, 1959 (Tamil Nadu Act 22 of 1959), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Hindu Religious Institutions Employees (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2020:-

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 9, in sub-rule (2),-

- (1) in clause (c), for the expression "Committee", the expression "Committee or Committees" shall be substituted;
- (2) after clause (d), the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided that, if more than one Committee is constituted, each committee for interviewing the candidates shall consist of (1) Chairman or one Trustee or Fit Person or Executive Office of the temple or an official nominated by the commissioner, where the number of Committee exceeds the number of trustees; (2) Two experts in the subject concerned; (3) An official nominated by the Joint Commissioner of the region, where the religious institution is situated".
