Tamil Nadu Acts and Ordinances

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 15th December 2025 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 55 OF 2025.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University Act, 1996.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

2023. | 3. In section 21 of the principal Act, for the expression, “section 21 of the Indian Penal Code”, the expression “clause (28) of section 2 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Central Act 45 of 2023)” shall be substituted. | Amendment of section 21. |
| | 4. In section 58 of the principal Act, in sub-section (2), the expression “or deaf- mute” shall be omitted. | Amendment of section 58. |
