AMENDMENTS TO THE SPECIAL RULES FOR THE POST OF JUNIOR ELECTRICIAN AND
JUNIOR MECHANIC OF THE TAMIL NADU GOVERNMENT PRESS SUBORDINATE SERVICE
FOR THE TAMIL NADU SERVICES MANUAL 2016.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Government Press Subordinate Service in Section 14 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 2016.

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force at once.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, in the ANNEXURE, in the TABLE, under the heading "CLASS VIII - ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL",-

(1) under the sub-heading "GROUP (A) ELECTRICAL", for the entries in columns (2) and (3), against the entry "(4) Junior Electrician" in column (1) thereof, the following entries shall respectively be substituted, as follows:-

"By direct recruitment

(1) Must have passed S.S.L.C examination or its equivalent; and

(2) Must possess the appropriate Technical Trade Certificate from any of the Institutions approved and recognized by the Government and must have put a minimum period of apprenticeship prescribed under Apprenticeship Act, 1961 (Central Act 52 of 1961);

(or)

Must possess a Diploma in Electrical and Electronics Engineering awarded by the Directorate of Technical Education.";

(2) under the sub-heading "GROUP (B) MECHANICAL", for the entries in columns (2) and (3), against the entry "(6) Junior Mechanic" in column (1) thereof, the following entries shall respectively be substituted, as follows: -

"By direct recruitment

(1) Must have passed S.S.L.C examination or its equivalent; and

(2) Must possess the appropriate Technical Trade Certificate from any of the Institutions approved and recognized by the Government and must have put a minimum period of apprenticeship prescribed under Apprenticeship Act, 1961 (Central Act 52 of 1961);

(or)

Must possess a Diploma in Mechanical Engineering awarded by the Directorate of Technical Education."
