NOTIFICATION CALLING UPON ALL ASSEMBLY CONSTITUENCIES IN THE STATE OF
TAMIL NADU TO ELECT MEMBERS

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Clause (1) of Article 172 of the Constitution of India, the existing Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu, unless sooner dissolved, shall continue up to and including the **10th May, 2026** and shall, thereafter, stand dissolved on the expiration of its duration; and

WHEREAS, in terms of Sub-section (1) of Section 15 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), a General Election has to be held for the purpose of constituting a new Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu; and

NOW, THEREFORE, as recommended by the Election Commission of India, in pursuance of Sub-section (2) of Section 15 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Governor of the State of Tamil Nadu, is hereby pleased to call upon all Assembly Constituencies in the State of Tamil Nadu, to elect members to the Legislative Assembly of the State, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder.
