"WHEREAS, Thiru. C. Joseph Vijay, has been declared duly elected to more than one seat to the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly, viz., from 12-Perambur Assembly Constituency and 141-Tiruchirappalli (East) Assembly Constituency;

WHEREAS, in pursuance of rule 91 of the Conduct of Election Rules, 1961 read with Section 70 of the Representation of People Act, 1951, (Central Act 43 of 1951) Thiru. C. Joseph Vijay, has, in his letter dated the 10th May 2026, addressed to me as the Speaker of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly, resigned his seat in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly from 141-Tiruchirappalli (East) Assembly Constituency with effect from the 10th May, 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, M. Appavu, Speaker of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly hereby accept the resignation of Thiru. C. Joseph Vijay of his seat in 141-Tiruchirappalli (East) Assembly Constituency under Article 190(3) (b) of the Constitution of India and the said seat shall thereupon become vacant with effect from the 10th May 2026.
