Tamil Nadu Acts and Ordinances

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 4th February 2026 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 2 OF 2026.

An Act to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent on certain services and purposes during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2023 in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services and purposes for that year.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation Act, 2026. Short title.
2. The sum specified in column (5) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to forty-nine thousand and eight hundred rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2023, in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services and purposes for that year. Issue of Rs.49,800/- out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2023.
3. The sum deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State under section 2 shall be appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2023. Appropriation.
