- (ii) The said Motor Vehicles Tax (Bilateral Tax) of Rs.5000/-(Rupees five thousand only) +11% cess i.e. Rs.5550/-(Rupees five thousand five hundred and fifty only) per vehicle per annum shall be paid in advance in one lump sum before the 15th of April every year, failing which an additional sum of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) for each calendar month, or part thereof shall be paid as penalty, in addition to the aforesaid tax;
