2. In the reference second read above, the Government of India has approved the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) a scheme of Ministry of Tribal Affairs for its implementation during a period of 5 years from the financial year of 2024-25 to 2028-29 in the States/UTs. The Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) envisages comprehensive development of tribal areas and communities by addressing critical gaps in infrastructure, healthcare, education and livelihoods, through a coordinated approach and convergence of various schemes of Government of India including Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) of Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India. The Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) aims to improve the socio-economic conditions of tribal communities by adopting saturation coverage for tribal families in tribal-majority villages and Aspirational Blocks. The interventions envisaged under Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) will be prioritized for Scheduled Tribe (ST) beneficiaries in tribal villages of Aspirational blocks and the pockets of high tribal concentration and low development. In accordance with the above, the Commissioner of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare has stated that they have requested the concerned subordinate Offices to submit the proposal pertaining to the above scheme regarding ST Beneficiaries.

3. In the reference third read above, the Commissioner of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare has requested the Government to accord permission to use the G.O. (Ms.) No.90, Animal Husbandry, Dairying, Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare (FS-3(2)) Department, dated 29.07.2020 in same line of the State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee at the State level as well as the District Level Committee at the District Level comprising of the member list and roles/responsibilities and Terms of References for the smooth implementation, supervision and monitoring of projects sanctioned under the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme for a period of 5 (five) years from 2024-25 to 2028-29 in the State.

4. The Government after careful examination of the request of the Commissioner of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare hereby orders to reconstitute the State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee (SLAMC) and District Level Committee (DLC) comprising the following members and roles/responsibilities and Terms of References for implementation of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme including supervision and monitoring of both the schemes:-

#### **TERMS OF REFERENCES (ToRs)**

##### **Roles and Responsibilities of State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee**

The State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee (SLAMC) will be responsible for consolidation of District Annual Fisheries Plans and preparation and approval of the State Annual Fisheries Plan and recommending to the Department of Fisheries, Government of India/National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad.

a. The State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee will be responsible for implementation of Aquaculture and Fisheries Development activities of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the

Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme at the State Level including the supervision and monitoring of both schemes.

b. The State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee would be assisted by the State Programme Unit (SPU) for the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme.

c. The State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee will undertake convergence of activities of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme with the activities/interventions of other schemes and programmes at the State level.

d. The State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee will facilitate fostering of linkages with Banks/Financial Institutions for smooth implementation of beneficiary oriented Sub-components / activities of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme.

The Chairperson may nominate additional District officials as felt necessary and may also nominate a maximum of 2 non-official eminent persons of the district preferably having knowledge of or associated with fisheries sector.

#### TERMS OF REFERENCES (ToRs)

##### The Roles and responsibilities of District Level Committee

a) The District Level Committee will be responsible for preparation and approval of the Annual District Fisheries Plan and recommending to the State Level Approval and Monitoring Committee.

b) The District Level Committee will be responsible for the implementation of Aquaculture and Fisheries Development activities of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme at the District Level including its supervision and monitoring.

c) The District Level Committee will be responsible for approval of beneficiaries for Beneficiaries oriented individual/group activities of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme.

d) The District Level Committee would be assisted by the District Programme Unit (DPU) in such districts wherever created by Government of India, Department of Fisheries.

e) The District Level Committee will undertake convergence of activities for the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme with the activities/interventions of other Schemes and programmes at the District level.

f) The District Level Committee will facilitate fostering of linkages with Banks/Financial Institutions for smooth implementation of beneficiary oriented Sub-components/activities of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) scheme.
