Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service.

No. SRO B-51/2025.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service (Section 22 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 2016).

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules,

(1) in rule 35, in sub-rule (ab), after the second proviso, the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided also that on and from the 18th January 2019, a person appointed as Assistants in a department and Senior Revenue Inspector in Revenue department by transfer from the category of Steno-Typist Grade III, after completion of 53 years of age, need not undergo the said Foundational Training.";

(2) in Annexure V, in the tabular column, under the heading "All Departments" in Serial Number 9, after the first proviso, the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided also that on and from the 18th January 2019, a person appointed as Assistant in a department and Senior Revenue Inspector in Revenue Department by direct recruitment, after completion of 53 years of age, need not undergo the said Foundational Training".

Amendments to the Special Rules for the post of Assistant Commissioner Class LXVIII in the Commissionerate of Land Reforms for Tamil Nadu General Service.

No. SRO B-52/2025.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Service (Section 16 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 1st December, 1980.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules,

(1) in Part I, in Class LXVIII, for the expression "Assistant Secretary, Board of Revenue (Land Reforms) redesignated as Assistant Commissioner in the office of the Director of Land Reforms", the expression "Assistant Commissioner in the office of the Commissionerate of Land Reforms" shall be substituted;

(2) in Part II, in Class LXVIII,-

(a) in the heading, for the expression "Assistant Secretary, Board of Revenue (Land Reforms) redesignated as Assistant Commissioner in the office of the Director of Land Reforms", the expression "Assistant Commissioner in the office of the Commissionerate of Land Reforms." shall be substituted;

(b) for rule 1, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"1. Constitution.- This class shall consist of the Assistant Commissioner in the office of the Commissionerate of Land Reforms."

(c) for rule 2, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"2. Appointment.- Appointment to the post shall be made by recruitment by transfer from among the superintendents in the office of the Commissionerate of Land Reforms or if no suitable person is available, from among the Deputy Collectors in the Tamil Nadu Civil Service.";

(d) for rule 3, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"3. Qualification.- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post from the holders of the post of Superintendent in the office of the Commissionerate of Land Reforms unless he has completed a total service for a period of not less than five years in the category of Superintendent, in that office.";

(e) for rule 5, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"5. Probation- Every person appointed to the post from the holders of the post of Superintendent in the office of the Commissionerate of Land Reforms shall be on probation for a total period of one year on duty, within a continuous period of two years."

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 5, in sub-rule (b), in the TABLE, after the entry in item No.3 in column (2) against the entry of "1. Direct Recruitment" in column (1) the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"provided that the candidates who have obtained a degree in B.E., (Civil Engineering), a postgraduate degree in M.E or M.Tech., must have passed Tamil as one of the subjects in S.S.L.C., Level.
