Amendment to the Adhoc rules governing the post of Assistant Librarian in the Government Law Colleges

No. SRO B-16/2026.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the adhoc rules published with Education Department Notification S.R.O. No.A179, dated 8th February, 1972 at pages 211-212 of Part-V of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* dated the 15th March, 1972, as subsequently amended.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, for rule 4, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"4. Qualification:- No person shall be eligible to appointment to the post unless he possesses,-

- (i) A Bachelor's Degree of a University recognized by the University Grants Commission;
- (ii) A Bachelor's Degree in Library Science or Library and Information Science of a University recognized by the University Grants Commission; and
- (iii) A pass in the Account test for Subordinate Officers Part- I:

Provided that a candidate for appointment by direct recruitment to the post need not possess at the time of selection the qualification in item (iii) above".

Re-Issue the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Legal Educational Subordinate Service

No. SRO B-17/2026.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby re-issues the Section-58, Tamil Nadu Legal Educational Subordinate Service, in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Service Manual, 2016.

(2) The rules hereby re-issued shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*.

RULES

1. Constitution.- The service shall consist of the category of Electrician.

2. Appointment.- Appointment to the category of Electrician shall be made by direct recruitment or by recruitment by transfer from any other service.

3. Appointing authority.- The appointing authority to the category of Electrician shall be the Director of Legal Studies.

4. Qualifications (a) Age.- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the category of Electrician, if he has completed or will complete the age of thirty years on the first day of July of the year in which the vacancy is notified.

(b) Other qualifications.- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the category of Electrician, unless he possesses the following qualification:-

- (i) Must possess minimum general educational qualification;
- (ii) Must have obtained a certificate in craftsmanship in electric wiring issued by the Department of Industries and Commerce; or a Wireman's Competency Certificate granted by the Government; and
- (iii) Must possess practical experience as an Electrician for a period of not less than five years.

5. Probation.- Every person appointed to the category by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
