No. SRO B-9/2026.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the rules issued with be Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Training-1) department notification S.RO.No.3-68/2019 published at page 119 in Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 25th September 2019, as subsequently amended.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,-

(1) In rule 3, in the "TABLE", for the entries "1(i) Principal, All India Civil Services Coaching Centre" and "(ii) Principal, Competitive Examinations Coaching Centre", in column (1) and corresponding entries column (2) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively by substituted, namely:-

"1. (1) Principal, All India Civil Services Coaching Centre	(i) By direct recruitment (ii) By Recruitment by Transfer from among the holders of any of the categories in class-IIIA in the Tamil Nadu Collegiate Educational Service. (iii) By Recruitment by Transfer from among the holders of Group "A" Category post under the State Government.
(ii) Principal, Competitive Examinations Coaching Centre	By Recruitment by Transfer from among the holders of any of the categories in class-IIIA in the Tamil Nadu Collegiate Educational Service

(2) After rule 3, as so amended, the following rule shall be inserted, namely: -

"3A) Selection Committee.- The appointment to the post of Principal, All India Civil Services Coaching Centre shall be made by the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee shall consist of the following officers, namely:

THE TABLE

1. Director General of Training	Chairperson
2. Experts from any University under the Government of Tamil Nadu or from outside, having expertise in coaching for the Civil Services Examination conducted by the Union Public Service Commission	Member
3. Director of Employment and Training	Member
4. Deputy Secretary / Joint Secretary / Additional Secretary to Government, Human Resources Management Department.	Member

The Selection Committee shall, by conducting interview, select the candidate based on his merit and suitability to the post and recommend the most suitable candidate for appointment to the Government".

(3) after rule 4, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-

"4A Qualifications. - (a) Age - No person shall be eligible for appointment unless he has not completed 35 years of age as on the 1st January of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

(b) Other qualifications. - No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post specified in column (1) of the table below by the method specified in column (2) thereof, unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof: -

Provided that, other things being equal, preference shall be given to candidates who possess at least two years of experience in training students for UPSC Civil Services Examination; proficiency in Tamil Language, and mentoring and analytical skills".
