In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 122 of the Code of Civil Procedure 1908 (Central Act V of 1908) and all other powers hereunto enabling and with the previous approval of the Government of Tamil Nadu, the High Court of Madras, hereby makes the following amendment to the Rules of the High Court, Madras, Appellate Side, 1965. The amendment shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in Order IV, in Rule 33, the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

“Provided that when several petitions are filed with a common affidavit, it shall not be duplicated and filing of one common affidavit shall suffice.”
